Tutorials on posting results in EudraCT

In order to post results in EudraCT, please follow the steps below:

1. Set up an [EMA account](#) and use the new credentials to [register as results user](#) in EudraCT and [log in](#) again).
→ In case of login problems (inactive accounts/forgotten password): refer to [EMA a](#)
2. [Request assignment to become the primary user for your trial](#): download the [form](#), and [in](#), click on "your page" and "request assignment", insert your trial's details and upload
3. Ask another person to set up an EMA account and register as results user (see step 1)
4. Go to "your page", click on "edit" nearby your trial and [upload results as](#)

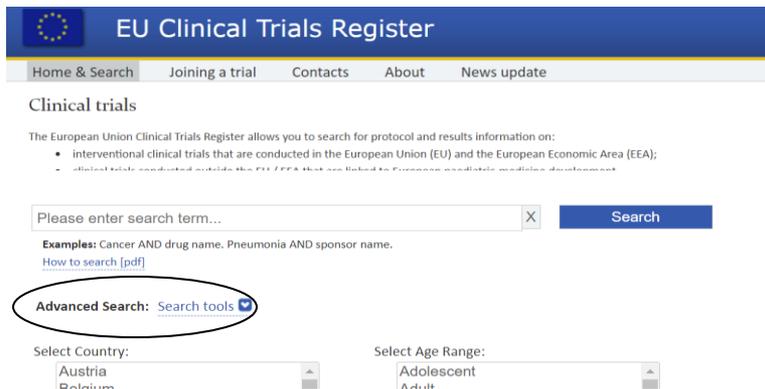

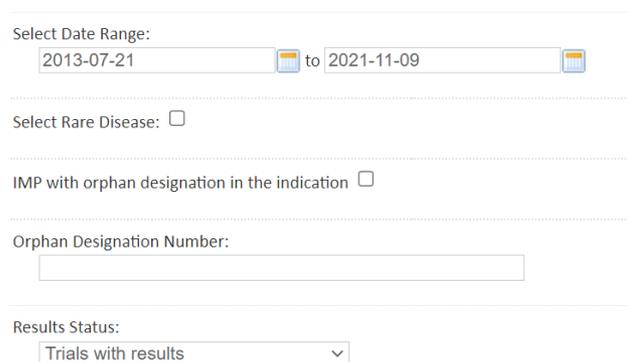
