

BIH Johanna Quandt Professors: Chairs of the Next Generation

For the second time, Stiftung Charité supports the establishment of new W2 professorships with a real tenure track at the Berlin Institute of Health (BIH). The BIH Johanna Quandt Professorships will attract a new generation of women scientists to Berlin and establish an innovative format for professorships, which which is also a role model beyond Berlin.

What constitutes the BIH Johanna Quandt Professorships?

- Equal opportunities: Professorships for women who, after completing their PhDs, have attained their own academic profile and initial academic independence and have international experience
- Real Tenure Track: Professorships with a binding option for permanent tenure as a lifetime professorship
- Topic openness: Professorships without a given subject; appointments are made in a subject area chosen by the applicant herself from the entire spectrum of the life and health sciences.

What conditions are offered for the BIH Johanna Quandt Professorships?

- W2 professorship for five years with option of subsequent tenure as W2 or W3 lifetime professorship (real tenure track), whereby the conditions for tenure are bindingly determined before the appointment on time
- 1.5 to 3.15 million euros of funding for salary and endowment over the first five years

Where are the BIH Johanna Quandt Professorships located?

- Joint appointment by BIH and Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin for the first five years; Stiftung Charité is funding agency and partner
- Continuation as permanent full professors in cooperation between BIH,
 Charité Universitätsmedizin Berlin, and Max Delbrück Center for Molecular
 Medicine, tailored to fit the candidates' profiles and the professorship designs

What do I need to bring when I would like to apply?

- Own scientific profile through achievements in research, teaching, transfer and, if applicable, patient care as well as international experience
- An innovative and interdisciplinary concept for your own BIH Johanna Quandt professorship
- Application deadline: June 24, 2019
