A wearable device for continuous, non-invasive, and remote patient vital sign monitoring. The device monitors physiological parameters (photoplethysmography (PPG), heart rate, blood oxygen saturation (SpO2) algorithm, heart rate variability (HRV), electrocardiogram (EKG/ECG), and body temperature) and sends them directly to any device via bluetooth connection, displaying real time data and alarms directly on a caretaker's mobile, tablet or PC

#### Project goal:

Robust, accurate, scalable, and actionable vital signs data for hundreds of patients concurrently transmitting to a local cloud-based server.

#### Project type:
